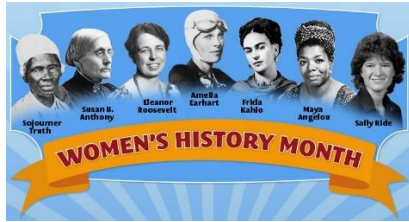
***Our first fish fry was not as a successful as we would have wanted too, however, the second one we just had was a huge success. We learned from our mistakes and we made the necessary changes.***

**Women's History Month: March 2021**

National Women's History Month traces its roots to March 8, 1857, when women from various New York City factories staged a protest over poor working conditions. The first Women's Day celebration in the United States was in 1909, also in New York City. More than seven decades later, Congress in 1981 established National Women's History Week to be commemorated annually the second week of March. In 1987, Congress expanded the week to a month, and every year since has passed a resolution (and the president has issued a proclamation) designating March Women's History Month.

As we celebrate Women's History Month 2021, we reflect upon advances women have made over the last decade. Women have increased their earnings and education and fields of occupation.

**Woman of the WEEK: Sonia Sotomayor**



Sotomayor became the youngest judge in the Southern District and the first Hispanic

federal judge in New York State. She became the first Puerto Rican woman to serve as a judge in a U.S. federal court. She was one of seven women among the district's 58 judges.
